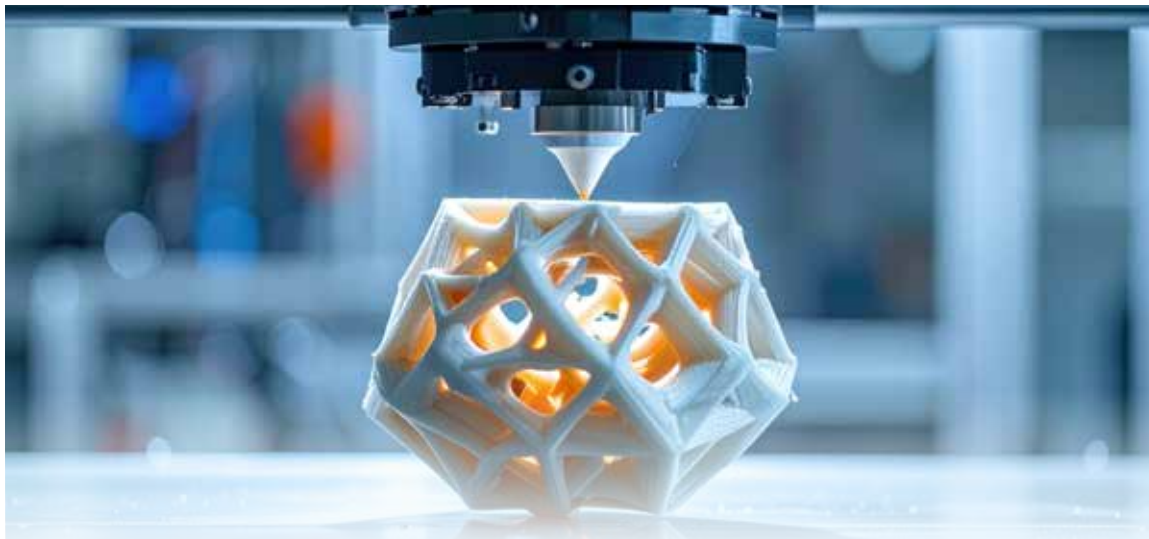


Library Resources for Soldiers
