You deserve to feel safe.

Your home should be a place of safety, warmth and comfort for you and your children.



Are you in an abusive relationship? Domestic abuse can be:

Physical:

Shoving, slapping, kicking, punching or strangling.

Emotional:

Manipulating, pressuring, controlling or gaslighting.

Verbal:

Criticizing, discounting, ridiculing, yelling or making demeaning jokes.

Financial:

Limiting or controlling access to money or assets.

Technological:

Misusing digital or mobile devices to monitor, harass or track activity.

You have options for reporting domestic abuse:

You can file a **Restricted Report** with FAP. Military law enforcement and the Chain of Command will not be notified, but you and your Family may be eligible to receive counseling, medical treatment, victim advocacy, limited legal support and emergency assistance.

You can file an **Unrestricted Report**. You and your Family may be eligible to receive counseling, medical treatment, victim advocacy, limited legal support and emergency assistance. Military law enforcement and the Chain of Command will be notified, and the offender can be held accountable for the abuse. An Unrestricted Report also allows you to seek a military or civilian protective order.

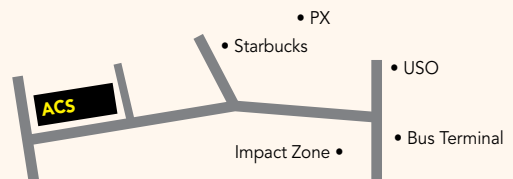

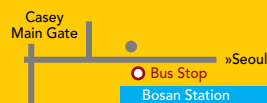
